Iowa's first community-owned solar garden is now generating electricity! Your solar module began producing clean, renewable power for the cooperative last week. Watch for your first actual monthly production credit on the December bill* ... and remember, power production will increase as the days get longer.



Inverter shed houses two German-engineered, SMA Sunny Boy inverters to convert DC to AC. There's room in the shed for more inverters as the solar garden expands.

Sixty solar modules (six per array) are now online. Two empty array racks (front, right) are in place for twelve additional modules. These are now available for \$500 per module. Contact FEC for details.

As you can see, there's plenty of space to expand the solar garden. We'll be adding more arrays in the future.
